Tentative Program Schedule (subject to amendment)

Week One

- Arrival at Lima on Wednesday, July 4th.
- Thursday, July 5th, group will have free time to get acclimated.
- Friday, July 6th, the class will have an "orientation" at the host university (USIL) that will take up the morning of that day.
- Friday, July 6th, we'll have lunch in USIL Culinary School followed by afternoon free time for the group.
- Saturday, July 7th, the class will have an organized City Tour of Lima (will take up ½ the day)
- Sunday, July 8th free time for the group

Week Two

- Monday -- Thursday (July 9th-12th), the group will have class from 9 a.m. to 12 noon. We will arrive back at our hotel by 1:00 p.m. each day and students will have the remainder of the day/evening as free time.
- Thursday, July 12th (or Friday July 13th, if necessary): trip to Iquitos/Amazon
- Return from Iquitos/Amazon Sunday, July 15th.

Week Three

Week Four

- We have class Monday (23rd) and Tuesday (24th).
- Wednesday, July 25th, we will fly to Cuzco in the A.M (free day in Cusco).
- Thursday, July 26th, we will take a *HALF-day* tour of Cuzco and surrounding areas.

- Friday, July 27th, we will go to Aguas Calientes to SPEND ONE NIGHT THERE IN A HOTEL
