



Salzburg College Summer Internship Program 2018

May 12 – August 4, 2018

The Summer Internship Program is both an academic and an applied learning program. Students complete two courses during the Summer Sessions I & II followed by six weeks of immersion in their full-time internship. Students are required to take one German language course, the course "The European Experience" as well as participate in special internship preparatory meetings. Prior German knowledge is not required. Salzburg College works closely with qualified students before their arrival and during their first weeks in Salzburg to select an internship placement that best fits each individual student's personal, language and academic needs.

Academic Courses

The European Experience: History, Politics, Society and Culture

German Language Instruction (all levels)

International Internship Course

Internship students are expected to enroll in **two** academic courses as well as the internship for a total of 9 U.S. credit hours. Students are also encouraged to audit other courses relevant to their internship.

Excursions

A 2-day trip to Vienna, Austria's historical capital, will provide a broad range of experiences related to history, art, music, and modern life. In addition, a variety of local field trips and excursions constitute an integral part of the academic program. There is also some time for independent travel on weekends.

Housing

To maximize cultural involvement, students live in Austrian homes where they also take their breakfasts and dinners. Family accommodation is usually reserved for students up to the age of 26, alternate options are available. Weekday lunches are provided by Salzburg College during the first 5 weeks.
