Did you know?	The first private botanical gardens in Europe were built by the Farnese family on the Palatine. The cardinal Alessandro Farnese purchased a section of the Palatine in 1550 and created beautiful botanical gardens, featuring a nymphaeum, an aviary, and a wealth of art. Although the gardens fell into disuse over time, some parts can still be visited today.

Itinerary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Full-day Vatican and Museum Tour • Private motor coach arrives at the hotel and provides full-day transportation in Rome • <i>Included admission: Museum of the History of Sanitary Arts, Museum and Crypts of Capuchin under Santa Maria della Concezione holds the bones of some 4,000 dead Capuchin monks, Vatican Museums, Sistine Chapel and St Peter's Basilica</i>
Dining	Breakfast: Provided at hotel
Helpful Tip	Entry to the Vatican Museums, the Sistine Chapel, St. Peter's Basilica and the Vatican Gardens is permitted only to appropriately dressed visitors. Low cut or sleeveless clothing, shorts, miniskirts and hats are not allowed. Please note this strict dress code is enforced at the guard's discretion.

Florence to Padua	Take public rail from Florence Santa Maria Novella station to Padua.

Day 9

Day	Friday, May 11, 2018
Itinerary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Walk to Padua rail station on own and take rail from Padua to Venice (open ticket, no seat reservations. Trains leave every 5 minutes, duration 14-min to 50-min) • Upon arrival in Venice, guide meets at Venice St Lucia rail station • Enjoy a 3-hour walking tour of Venice • Private gondola ride at the Bauer Gondola Station • Free time for the remainder of the afternoon in Venice • Rail transfer on own back to Padua. These typically run every 5 minutes. • <i>Included admission: Doges Palace, St Mark's Basilica, rail ticket from Venice to Padua and private 35-minute gondola ride.</i>
