




# GETTING STARTED

# APPLYING TO A UCF ABROAD SCHOLARSHIP



1

- ❖ Navigate to the Scholarships & Finances Tab - UCF Scholarships and Opportunities.
- ❖ Review the eligibility requirements and instructions.
- ❖ Click “Apply Now.”

- ❖ Select the term.
- ❖ Sign into the application system using your UCF NID and NID password.
- ❖ You will be redirected to the Scholarship Program Application page.
- ❖ Review and sign Signature Documents for the terms and conditions of the scholarship.

- ❖ Copy and paste your essay into the Application Questionnaires box. The essay prompt is displayed here as well.
- ❖ Send a letter of recommendation request using the Recommendations box.
- ❖ Return to your application at any time by logging back into Terra Dotta via [studyabroad.ucf.edu](http://studyabroad.ucf.edu).

# SEARCHING AND APPLICATION TIPS

- Write out a short list of things that make you YOU and search for scholarships that award those attributes.

- Don't get overwhelmed! Take 15 mins to look for scholarships when you can.
- Write down what you find and make notes about each scholarship:
  - Requirements
  - Deadlines
  - Awards



- Apply to more than one scholarship!
- Apply early.
- Review all the requirements and deadlines – make sure you don't miss anything.
